

## APPOINTMENT GUIDELINES

1.	We show our puppies and adults by appointment only. Since there are times when we may not be available or simply walking dogs at the back of the property, we kindly ask that you arrange a time for us to show you our animals.
2.	For the health and development of the puppies, we begin showing our puppies at “4” weeks of age, and we show our adults year round.
3.	We do realize that many of you are “puppy shopping,” however when you are coming to see our puppies or our adults labs, we kindly ask that when coming to our farm, you pick a day that we are the <b>ONLY</b> kennel you visit. Puppies are very vulnerable at a young age, and we work hard to keep our puppies healthy, and we do not want any other potential health concern unknowingly brought to our farm. (Thank you for your understanding!)
4.	<p>We encourage entire families to come see our puppies, however as these babies are typically under six weeks of age (and still fragile), we ask that children under five do not pick up the puppies. They are, however, certainly welcome to sit on the floor and pet them. We also ask that your children stay with you at all times.</p> <p>And finally, although it has only happened on a few occasions, if we see a child mishandling a puppy, we will <b>NOT</b> sell you one of our puppies. We cannot knowingly place a puppy in an environment where either the “puppy” or the “child” may potentially be injured.</p>
5.	We ask that you leave your pets at your home. Some of our mommas are “very protective” of their puppies and we would not want any injuries to your pet.
6.	Bring your cameras!
7.	And finally, if we sound picky, you’re right! These are our beloved animals and we want to bring you the best puppies in the country – and we hope it shows!
